Nottingham Cathedral was built between 1841 and 1844 and at its opening was the largest Roman Catholic church to have been built in England since the

Reformation. Originally a parish church, it became a cathedral with the restoration of the Catholic hierarchy in 1850. The architect and designer of its decoration and main furnishings was the celebrated A. W.N. Pugin
